I JOHN 3:18

1. God's Greatest Commandments

Love God With All Your Heart, Soul and Might! Love Your Neighbor as Yourself! (Deut 6:5) (Matt 22:39)

We know about love only because God first loved us. (I John 4:19)

We know what love is because Jesus Christ laid down His life for us. We ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. I John 3:16)

2. But would we really give up our own lives for our brother? (FSBH)

This is what we are commanded but could we do it if we were faced with the challenge?

3. I don't believe too many people could give up their lives for another, but we CAN give up our TIME and get involved in their lives and help them! (FSBH)

i. If anyone has material things and does not help his brother in NEED, how can the love of God be in him? (I John 3:17)

Care and concern
Fellowship
Friendship
Temporary housing
Medication if needed
Help in obtaining Birth Certificate and ID
Food
Clothing
Monetary aid in non-cash forms
Job searching
Career counseling
Transportation
Permanent housing assistance
Help in securing benefits if applicable
Follow up and maintenance of all the above
Secure and ensure a self-sufficient lifestyle

Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love! (I John 4:8)

If we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us! (I John 4:8)

We should not consider doing anything else in life, after we ourselves are self-sufficient, until we do all the above to raise the Homeless to self-sufficiency and give spiritual and financial help and love to the poor. (FSBH)

Overcoming fear, taking a little risk and sacrificing a little love and time is the ONLY answer to helping the Homeless effectively. I believe God wants PEOPLE to love people, not the government!
